Final Conference in Trento

The PreMo project is coming to an end this year. However, the collaboration between the mobility operators and the synergies between PreMo and TRACK will remain and will be reinforced in the next coming period.

On the 13rd and 14th of November, the final conference of both initiatives (PreMo and TRACK) will take place in

Trento.

Besides closing the projects and promoting the results, it will be an event in which the continuation of the collaboration between the partners will be celebrated and formalized. A signing session will take place in which the PreMo and TRACK mobility operators will sign the collaboration agreement.

The PreMo Vortal is operational!

In the previous newsletter, the PreMo Vortal is introduced as being a common platform, bringing together services in mobility from all over Europe. Both mobility operators as beneficiaries of mobility can use this Vortal for their mobility activities. Especially for mobility operators, this platform offers more than information and tools: It is a “meeting place” to get in contact with each other in order to facilitate and improve own mobility practices. This meeting place is a restricted area within the PreMo Vortal for the mobility operators who are member of the PreMo network. It offers an environment for exchange of tools, instruments and experiences. This community is also the place where mobility operators can get in contact with other mobility operators for requests for incoming and outgoing mobility.

Bringing together the results of TRACK and PreMo (part 2)

“One of the messages is to convince that mobility can help people to develop their skills and competences which are needed in the labour market.”

On the 13rd of November, during the Mobility event in Trento, 8 different workshops are planned to present the outcomes of PreMo and TRACK.

The entire events is centered around the promotion of mobility for learners, jobseekers, workers and educational professionals. Participants will be triggered to see mobility as a valuable option

and tool to improve their skills and career. People have to become aware that vocational education (with mobility !) is an attractive and relevant way to enter the labour market and/or to improve their career opportunities.

The main themes of the PreMo and TRACK conference are the **“Mobility skills needed in Europe 2020”** and **“Transnational mobility as a way to promote HR enhancement.** “Stakeholders from the world of work and education will be brought together to reflect on these topics from their point of view.
